Veterans Transitional Home

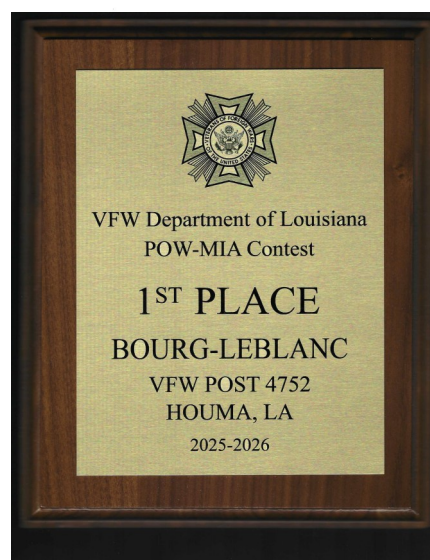
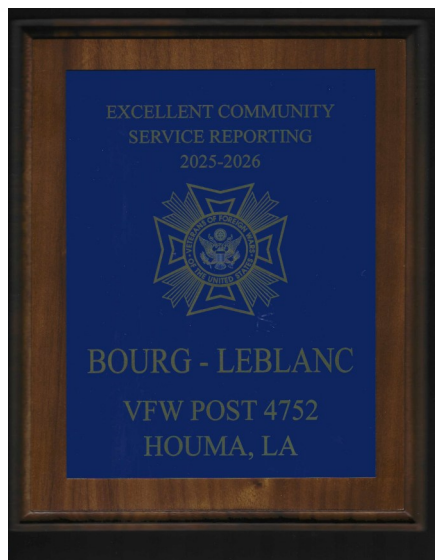
On June 17th, VFW Post 4752 provided lunch to the 22 Veterans residing in the Houma Veterans Transitional Home.
